SEPA MITIGATION MEASURES

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- 1. The project shall obtain a Shoreline Substantial Development, CUP and Variance permits and shall comply with all conditions of said permits.
- 2. The project shall comply with approved Habitat Management Plan.
- 3. This project shall comply with the Sumner Municipal Code the 2012 International Fire Code and the set standards of Sumner as established by the Fire Chief. (NFPA)
- 4. An approved addressable, automatic and manual fire alarm system is required in all structures 5,000 gross square feet or more. (SMC 15.24) A separate permit and submittal is required.
- An approved automatic sprinkler system is required in all structures 5,000 gross square feet or more. (SMC 15.24) Hazardous and specific occupancies at a lesser square footage per 2012 IFC. A separate permit and submittal is required.
- 6. Fire access lanes shall have an unobstructed width of 20 feet with a 28 foot minimum inside turning radius. (SMC 15.24)
- 7. Fire hydrants shall have a lateral spacing of 330 feet on site. (SMC 15.28)
